Putting your Starlite Forever Tree Together

The lighting system for your tree consists of 100 light sets connected in a revolutionary low voltage way. Your tree has an adapter that reduces the current going to every light set. One adapter can handle 36 light sets. A splitter plugs into the adapter.

Each splitter has two light sets and another splitter connected to it. That second splitter has two light sets and a third splitter connected to it. And so it continues throughout the entire tree.

First, plug the adapter into the wall outlet. The bottom section will illuminate. At the top of that section will be an empty splitter socket labeled A. Next, take the midsection and find the splitter labeled A which will be underneath the bottom of the section. Insert the midsection into the pole and connect the two A splitters. Make sure the connection fits together securely.

Likewise, all additional sections have splitters that plug into each other. They are identified by matching letters. Start from the bottom, A to A, B to B, and C to C. Although this is a new way of lighting, if your tree has three sections, you only need to make two connections.

If you have purchased a dimmer, plug the male end into the adapter and female end into the long splitter.
